**For payment and other administrative enquiries the School Office will be open all throughout the school holidays except for Monday 23 December 2019 to Tuesday 1 January 2020 inclusive.**

### PAYMENT OF FEES AND CHARGES

The School's preferred method of payment is by regular Direct Debit as it assists families to budget across the year rather than receive a larger term bill. Direct Debits are available either Fortnightly on a Thursday, or Monthly (on the 16th). The annual school fees and charges are calculated and divided into equal fortnightly or monthly installments. Please contact the Bookkeeper to initiate this option for payment.

Fees and charges may be paid by:

#### Direct Debit

Fees and charges (excluding uniforms) may be direct debited from a nominated cheque or savings account on a fortnightly or monthly basis.

#### Cash

Payable only at the School Office. Please do not send cash with students or through the mail.

#### Cheque

Cheques should be made payable to Georgiana Molloy Anglican School and may be mailed or paid at the School Office.

#### Credit Card

Bankcard, Mastercard and Visa only are acceptable. Payment may be made at the School Office, mailed with your remittance advice or by telephone. EFTPOS facilities are also available at the School Office.

#### EFT

Full term fees only can be paid electronically to the following account.

#### B-PAY

Full term fees only can be paid via B-Pay.

**If fees are not paid by the due dates above and you do not have a Direct Debit or other arrangement in place, then a 4% balance interest charge will apply each term.**

## REGISTRATION FEE

In order to register a student enrolment, an Application for Admission form must be completed and a fee of \$75.00 paid (including GST). This fee is not refundable and is designed to cover administration costs associated with enrolments. Please note that the payment of this fee does not guarantee enrolment.

## ENROLMENT CONFIRMATION FEE

Confirmation of the enrolment is dependent upon an interview with the Principal and upon the payment of an Enrolment Confirmation Fee. This fee is a contribution towards the existing buildings and educational facilities. Payment of the Enrolment Confirmation Fee will secure your child's place in the School.

The Enrolment Confirmation Fee is payable at the time a confirmed placement is offered. The fee is non-refundable and consists of \$750.00 for the first child, \$150.00 for the second child and \$100 for the third child in the same family, to a maximum of \$1,000.00 per family.

## NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF ENROLMENT

The Principal **must** be given a **full term's notice in writing** prior to the withdrawal of a student from the School. In default of such notice, one term's fees will be charged in lieu of notice.

## TUITION FEES

Annual Tuition Fees for 2019 will be billed in 4 installments except for Year 12 which will be billed in 3 installments.

We encourage families to make an early payment of the full annual account by Monday 18 February 2019.

Tuition fees do not include the cost of texts, stationery, uniforms, excursions, school camps, co-curricular activities or voluntary instrumental music lessons.

GST: Most educational services will be GST free. Government per capita subsidies and other funding is paid directly to the School and has been taken into account in assessing the fees.

## RESOURCE LEVIES

**Annual Resource Levies for 2019 will be billed in 4 installments except for Year 12 which will be billed in 3 installments.**

These levies include one student diary, portfolio file (Kindy and Pre-Primary), Study Skills, (Middle School), photocopying, along with other general teaching consumable resources. Kindy – Year 6 levies include all items from their booklists.

## MATHLETICS LEVY FOR PP – 6

This is a compulsory levy for the use of Mathletics both at home and in the classroom. The cost is \$35 per student annually and will be billed direct to term fee accounts in Term 1.

## MATHSPACE YEARS 7 – 12

This is a compulsory levy for the use of Mathspace both at home and in the classroom. The cost is \$20 per student annually and will be billed direct to term fee accounts in Term 1. **Year 11 and 12 students will only be charged if they have elected a Mathematics subject.**

## COSMOS SCIENCE YEARS 7 – 9

This is a compulsory levy for the use of Cosmos Science both at home and in the classroom. The cost is \$26 per student annually and will be billed direct to term fee accounts in Term 1.

## ELECTIVE SUBJECT LEVIES FOR SECONDARY STUDENTS YR9 – YR12

## CLASS EXCURSIONS

These are charged out at cost and written advice comes to the families in advance of the excursion. Every effort is made to keep the costs of excursions to a minimum. **Once permission slips are signed no refunds will be given.**

## E-BOOKS LEVY YRS 7 - 10

To reduce the cost to parents purchasing books and at the same time increase the variety and range of texts studied in class there is a levy for English, Mathematics, Science and HASS for students in Years 7, 8, 9 and 10. The eBook Levy will be \$39 for each of these four subjects to cover annual licenses, billed in full in Term 1. This levy will considerably reduce the cost of books to parents on the booklists.

## ICT LEVY YRS 7 - 12

The ICT Levy will apply for Years 7 to 12 to supplement the Apple 1:1 technology program. 1:1 learning provides every Secondary School student access to their own laptop computer in a wireless environment allowing them to learn at their own pace and ability levels. 1:1 initiatives have gained momentum worldwide, and are increasingly seen as a key to transforming education, and better preparing students to succeed in a global world. The levy will be \$530.00 per annum and charged over 4 terms.

## YEAR GROUP CAMPS

Outdoor Education continues to be one of the pillars of the GMAS strategic plan and is now embraced and reflected in curriculum studies in Years 10 - 12. In 2019 there will be camps for Years K - 11 and a Reflection Retreat in Year 12.

Year Group Camps are a compulsory component of the School's overall program. Camps are held during Camp Week – towards the end of Term 1. **These camps are funded on student numbers and as they are compulsory no refunds will be given.** Camps will be billed in full in Term 1. Year 9 Canberra will be charged over 2 terms.

## **YEARBOOK**

All families will receive a copy of the School's Yearbook at an annual cost of \$39.00 per family.

## **VOLUNTARY TOURS**

The School offers students the opportunity for community service, cultural and sporting tours. These tours, while considered worthwhile by the School, are undertaken on a voluntary basis by students and parents. The cost will vary for each tour and will be advised well in advance of the tour. Tours planned for 2019 are: Cambodia Tour and Uluru Tour. Families must be up to date with their fees in order to attend the tour.

## **SCHOOL BUILDING LEVY AND SCHOOL BUILDING FUND**

All families are required to contribute to the School Building Fund as a condition of entry. This non-voluntary contribution is \$260.00 per family per year, billed in Term 1. The contributions are non-refundable and not claimable as a tax deduction.

However, the School operates a tax deductible Building Fund, the contributions to which are voluntary and therefore may be tax deductible (seek your own professional advice). Any contribution would be in addition to the compulsory levy. Please ensure you indicate your contribution is to the Building Fund to ensure a tax deductible receipt can be issued for your tax records. The School is currently raising money for future building programs.

## **FAMILY CONCESSION**

A reduction of 10% of the Tuition Fee is made for the second student member of the family attending the School, and 20% for each subsequent student of the family. The first child is the one in the highest year group; the second child is in the next year group and so on.

## **OVERDUE ACCOUNTS**

The School aims to keep fees and charges as low as possible while simultaneously providing 'best practice' experiences for your child. Parents/Guardians should read this document carefully and seek clarification from the Bookkeeper if unsure of requirements prior to enrolment.

Once enrolled, fees and charges must be paid in a timely manner. The School encourages families who may be experiencing difficulties to contact the Bookkeeper in advance of payment dates to negotiate arrangements suitable to the School. For families who find they are experiencing extreme financial hardship please contact the Bookkeeper for assistance.

Late payment of school fee accounts without contacting the Bookkeeper in advance, will incur an interest charge each school term of 4% on the outstanding balance. The School has a Debt Collection Policy which applies in such circumstances. In addition the Principal can withdraw a child's enrolment if fees and charges are not paid. A Debt Collection Agency may be engaged and/or legal action taken for recovery of outstanding fees where the school account remains unpaid. Costs including commissions, fees, legal expenses are payable by the Parent or Guardian.

## **UNIFORMS**

Uniforms are sold on campus and are not available elsewhere for purchase. The cost of uniforms varies depending on the age of the child, with the average price of a full uniform being in the order of \$500 (excluding a blazer). Please refer to the uniform price list for further details.
