School Fees are charged annually and issued at the start of the new academic year. Payment is due by Monday, 16 February 2026; unless an approved payment arrangement is in place. Please note that accounts are annual, not termly. The School's preferred method of payment is by direct debit. The annual fee statement will display the instalment options available for payment arrangements.

### **TUITION FEES**

Tuition fees do not include the cost of textbooks, stationery, uniforms, co-curricular activities or instrumental music lessons.

### RESOURCE LEVIES

Resource Levies cover the cost of student resources, excursions and incursions, elective subjects (with the exception of Advanced Physical Education and Outdoor Education), photocopying and general consumables that complement the delivery of the School's academic programme.

### **HOW TO PAY**

School fees may be paid by the following methods:

**Direct Debit/Credit Card Arrangements:** The school's preferred method of payment is by direct debit as per payment dates above.

**EFT bank transfer:** Fees can be paid electronically to the following account: BSB: 706001, Account: 30003692 using the account code as the reference.

**BPAY:** Fees can be paid by BPAY. Reference codes can be found on the annual statement.

**EFTPOS**: Fees can be paid via credit/debit card at the School Office or via telephone.

**Cheque:** Cheques can be made payable to Georgiana Molloy Anglican School and can be received by post or via the School Office in person.

Please note: Our School operates a cashless system. No cash payments are accepted.

## ADDITIONAL CHARGES

There are a number of additional charges that families should take into account.

### APPLICATION FEES

An application for admission must be completed and a non-refundable fee of \$75.00 (Including GST) must be paid. This fee is designed to cover administration costs associated with enrolments and interviews. Please note that this fee does not guarantee enrolment

### **ENROLMENT FEES**

Confirmation of enrolment is dependent upon a school interview and payment of a one-off non-refundable confirmation fee which is a contribution towards existing building and educational facilities. Payment of the confirmation fee secures your child's place at GMAS and cannot be offset against tuition fees. The confirmation fee is payable at the time a confirmed place is offered. The fee consists of \$750 for the first child, \$150 for the second child and \$100 for the third child, to a maximum of \$1000 per family. This fee is not deducted from the tuition fee account.

### RE-ENROLMENT FEE NOTICE

A re-enrolment fee of \$75.00 now applies to students returning to the School after a period of withdrawal. This fee helps cover administrative costs associated with processing returning students.

### SCHOOL BUILDING FUND

Separate to the compulsory school building levy, the School operates a Building Fund for voluntary contributions over and above the levy paid by all families. Any donations made are likely to be tax deductable; however, we encourage you to seek your own advice. This fund raises money for future building programs designed to enhance the student experience. These contributions are made via AngliSchools. For further information, please contact the Business Manager.

### **FAMILY CONCESSION**

When a family has two or more siblings attending the school at the same time, tuition fees are discounted by 10% for the second student and 20% for each subsequent student from the same family. This discount only applies to students in K-12.

### CONCESSION CARD HOLDERS

Parents/legal guardians in possession of a current eligible concession card (Centrelink Health Care Card, Pensioner Concession Card or Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Concession Card) are eligible for a 50% reduction in tuition fees. Concession is granted solely to the tuition fee (after family discount). The card holder must be the parent/legal guardian of the student/s while they remain enrolled. Please contact the Bookkeeper for more information.

### SECONDARY ASSISTANCE SCHEME (YRS 7-12)

The Department of Education offers an allowance to assist eligible families with the cost of secondary schooling. The allowance is payable to holders of Family Health Care Cards (not student cards), a Pensioner Concession Card, or Veterans' Affairs Card. If approved, the Department will pay \$300 directly to parents to assist with the purchase of uniforms and textbooks. \$235 is paid directly to the school to offset the school fee account. Application forms are available from the School Office and must be submitted by 2 April 2026.

### FINANCIAL HARDSHIP

Families who are experiencing temporary financial hardship are encouraged to contact our Bookkeeper to discuss how the school may assist. Options may include entering into a payment plan/arrangement or fee remission (in extreme circumstances).

### UNIFORMS

Students are required to wear the GMAS school uniform. Uniforms are sold on campus or through the online shop. Please refer to the uniform price list for further details.

### BOOKLISTS

Campion Education will be the School's booklist supplier in 2026.

Parents of students in Years 3–12 will be provided with login details to access booklists. These booklists include stationery, subscriptions, and other resources not covered by the Resource Levy.

Students in Kindy to Year 2 do not require booklists, as all necessary consumables are supplied by the School and covered through the Resource Levy.

### **ELECTIVE TRIPS & TOURS**

GMAS offers students the opportunity to participate in a variety of service, cultural and sporting tours. Attendance is voluntary and the cost varies for each tour. Families must be up to date with their fees in order for students to attend these trips.

### NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

Families must give a full school term's notice in writing to our Registrar vke@gmas.wa.edu.au prior to the withdrawal of a student from the School.

### **OVERDUE ACCOUNTS**

Once enrolled, fees and charges must be paid in a timely manner. We encourage families to contact our Bookkeeper if they find themselves unable to make payment by the due date, in order to negotiate a payment plan. If fees are not paid by the due date, and another arrangement is not in place, a 4% balance interest charge will apply whilst the balance remains outstanding.

### **DEBT COLLECTION POLICY**

The school has a debt collection policy which applies to outstanding accounts. This includes provisions for the school to cancel enrolments, engage a debt collection agency or to take legal action to recover any debt owed. Costs including commissions, fees and legal expense are payable by the parents in such circumstances. We prefer to work with our families to manage any financial difficulties in order to preserve the education and wellbeing of our students.
