PRIMARY SCHOOL MUSIC CLASSRO PROGRAM

CLASSROOM EDUCATION, MUSIC PROGRAMS AND ENSEMBLES



GMAS Primary School offers a strong foundational education in Music. Each week students receive a music class lesson based on the Kodaly method, combined with a colourful introduction to rhythmical and movement-based programs. They sing each week and develop a strong connection with their 'inner ear' so that by secondary school students have confident pitch and rhythmic skills. Their love of music is also fostered in these early years through a fun and imaginative exploration of the history of music.

In addition to classroom education, students are offered these free additional music programs and ensembles:

Year 2 String Program

Free instrument hire and a weekly group lesson introducing students to playing a string instrument and taking part in their first music ensemble.

Year 4 Band Program

Free instrument hire and a weekly group lesson introducing students to band instruments and playing in a large band.

Showstoppers Choir (Year 3-6)

Weekly rehearsals with Mrs Thompson, singing fun contemporary repertoire, with several performances at school and in the community each year.

Ukulalien Ensemble

Weekly rehearsals with Mrs Deroost learning basic ukulele skills whilst singing.

Junior Orchestra

Weekly rehearsals with Mrs Telchadder learning beginner orchestral repertoire, with performances at school and in the community.

Junior Band

Weekly rehearsals with Mrs Deroost learning beginner band repertoire, with performances at school and in the community.

SECONDARY SCHOOL MUSIC

CLASSROOM EDUCATION, MUSIC PROGRAMS AND ENSEMBLES



GMAS Secondary School has a rich music culture based on contemporary and classical performance as well as group ensemble work. Students experience the Music classroom elective in yr 7 and yr 8, and then can select Classroom Music in Year 9 and above. In addition to the ATAR music pathway, GMAS offers VET music certificate II & III to cater for the growing demand in tertiary opportunities and beyond. In addition to the classroom education, students are offered these music ensembles:

Year 8 & 9 Rock Band

A weekly band rehearsal with Mr Watts introducing students to playing in a rock band and learning introductory rock repertoire

Senior Choir (Years 7-12)

Weekly rehearsals with Mr Watts singing popular contemporary repertoire, with several performances at school and in the community each year

Senior Orchestra

Weekly rehearsals with Mrs Telchadder learning moderate to advanced orchestral repertoire, with performances at school and in the community

Senior Jazz Band

Weekly rehearsals with Mrs Deroost learning jazz and contemporary repertoire, with performances at school and in the community

Senior String Ensemble

Weekly rehearsals with Mrs Telchadder learning moderate to advanced string orchestral repertoire, with performances at school and in the community

School Production

Under the direction of Mrs Sue Thompson, students can audition for a place in the school production which takes place in August. Students will be coached in acting as well as singing on stage.

AV Club

Under the direction of GMAS Sound Technician Mr Dave Crossie and Secondary Media Specialist Ms Sophia Daryan, students are introduced to sound and media equipment and techniques, using the MAC as a primary sound venue.

PRIVATE INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC LESSON PROGRAM



GMAS offers the opportunity for students to take private individual music lessons whilst on campus with peripatetic music tutors. We are very fortunate to have a strong team of music tutors that have great experience and expertise in their specialist areas.

All students learning a musical instrument through the school are expected to participate in at least one ensemble suitable to their instrument or voice. see LINK

Enrolment and fees

Applications for music lessons are made online via the **<u>GMAS website</u>** and parents are charged by the tutor direct.

Lesson times are for 30 minutes and are rotated each week by the hour so students do not miss the same class subject more than twice a term. Tutors will email term lesson timetables at the beginning of each term.

Tuition fees are set by the tutor, and parents will be invoiced by tutors for each term:

Term 1 - 9 lessons

Term 2 - 9 lessons

Term 3 - 9 lesson

Term 4 - 6 lessons

(Year 12 students will finish lessons at the conclusion of Term 3 unless other arrangements are made with the Instrumental tutor)

Lesson Absences

If your child forgets to attend their lesson, the tutor will inform you that day by text or email. You will be charged for that lesson unless:

-In case of illness, the tutor has been notified before 7.30am that day

-In case of excursion/test/school event, the tutor has been notified 2 days prior

-In case of family holidays taken during term time, no lesson will be rescheduled

Cancellation of Music Lessons

You are required to commit to lessons for a term at a time and should advise the tutor and the Director of Music by the end of the term if you wish to no longer continue tuition for the following term.

Scholarships - St Mary's

Weekly rehearsals with Mr Watts singing Church repertoire, with monthly performances at St Marys Church. This is by audition entry only and recipients receive financial support towards music lesson fees.
