INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC TUITION 2025

Students at Georgiana Molloy Anglican School are currently offered individual or group instrumental music tuition for these instruments:

Violin, Viola, Cello, Double Bass, Flute, Clarinet, Saxophone, Trumpet, Trombone, French Horn, Voice, Piano, Guitar, Bass Guitar, Drums, Music Theory

The following free GMAS instrumental programs are offered in addition to private music lessons, and we encourage the uptake of the relevant instruments to suit these programs:

Year 2 Strings Program - (free tuition and instrument hire)
Year 4 Band Program - (free tuition and instrument hire)

Year 7&8 Rock Band

MUSIC LESSON PROCEDURES:

- 1. Most music tutors operate as independent contractors and are not employed directly by the school. Therefore, instrumental lesson payments must be remitted to the respective tutor either in advance or in a timely manner each academic term.
- 2. 30 Minute lessons take place within school hours on a rotating basis. Fixed lesson times can be negotiated with tutors, though these are at the discretion of the music tutor and are generally reserved for Senior School students.
- 3. Shared lessons are only offered if approved by the tutor, and if students of similar ability can be grouped together.
- 4. Parents and students need to be aware that the entire term's fee is payable whether the lessons are attended or not, as the student occupies one place in the Instrumental Program.
- When adequate notice is given regarding absences as outlined below, and where possible, the tutor will
 endeavor to make-up missed lessons. Ultimately, music teachers set the terms and conditions for
 missed lessons.
- 6. If your child is going to miss a lesson due to a test, exam or excursion, the tutor needs to be advised at least 2 days prior to the lesson so that alternate arrangements can be made if possible.
- 7. Secondary school students are expected to remember to attend lessons and will be given the term's lesson schedule at the commencement of each term. If your child forgets to attend the scheduled lesson, the tutor will advise the parent and student by email that day. No lesson will be made up unless the tutor can accommodate this at the end of the term.
- 8. If your child is unwell on the day of the lesson, please advise the tutor asap. Your tutor will supply you with contact details at the commencement of lessons. In this case, it is at the discretion of the tutor whether or not a catch up lesson can be scheduled.
- 9. Students missing shared lessons will not have those made-up as the lesson will still be taught to the other student who are present at school.

- 10. Tutors will re-schedule lessons if they conflict with calendared events, camps and whole school events such as Interhouse Athletics Carnivals.
- 11. Tutors are not obligated to reschedule lessons when the student is absent due to private family holidays taken during term time.
- 12. If the teacher is absent and the lesson cannot be rescheduled, a credit will be given.
- 13. Parents and students should be aware that for adequate progress to be made, there needs to be a commitment to practise regularly at least 4 days each week. Your tutor can give more specific advice in this area.
- 14. Only one instrument is recommended to be studied during school time due to interruption to classroom learning.
- 15. As part of the GMAS Instrumental Music Lesson program, students in Years 3-12 are highly encouraged to join at least one of the Arts co-curricular music ensembles in order to give themselves the best chance of making progress with their instrumental learning. These ensembles are free of charge and strongly compliment your child's musical education. Ensembles meet once a week and most take place before school. There is an expectation that your child participates in at least one of these ensembles if they are in Year 3 and above.

2025 FEE STRUCTURE:

The GMAS Instrumental Music Tutors sub-contracted by GMAS are our preferred suppliers. Fees are to be set by the individual music tutor (approx. \$38-47 an individual lesson and approx. \$25 - \$30 per group lesson). Tutors will charge parents directly for lessons, and students will be required to sign off for each lesson that they receive. The tutor has the right to stop lessons if accounts are not paid in a timely manner.

CANCELLING LESSONS

You are required to commit to lessons for a term at a time. Cancellation of lessons should be done in writing to both the tutor and ryo@gmas.wa.edu.au and be received by the following dates for each term;

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Term 2 cancellation – by Friday 28<sup>th</sup> March 2025
Term 3 cancellation – by Friday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2025
Term 4 cancellation – by Friday 19<sup>th</sup> September 2025
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No credits will be given if you decide to stop lessons after these dates.
